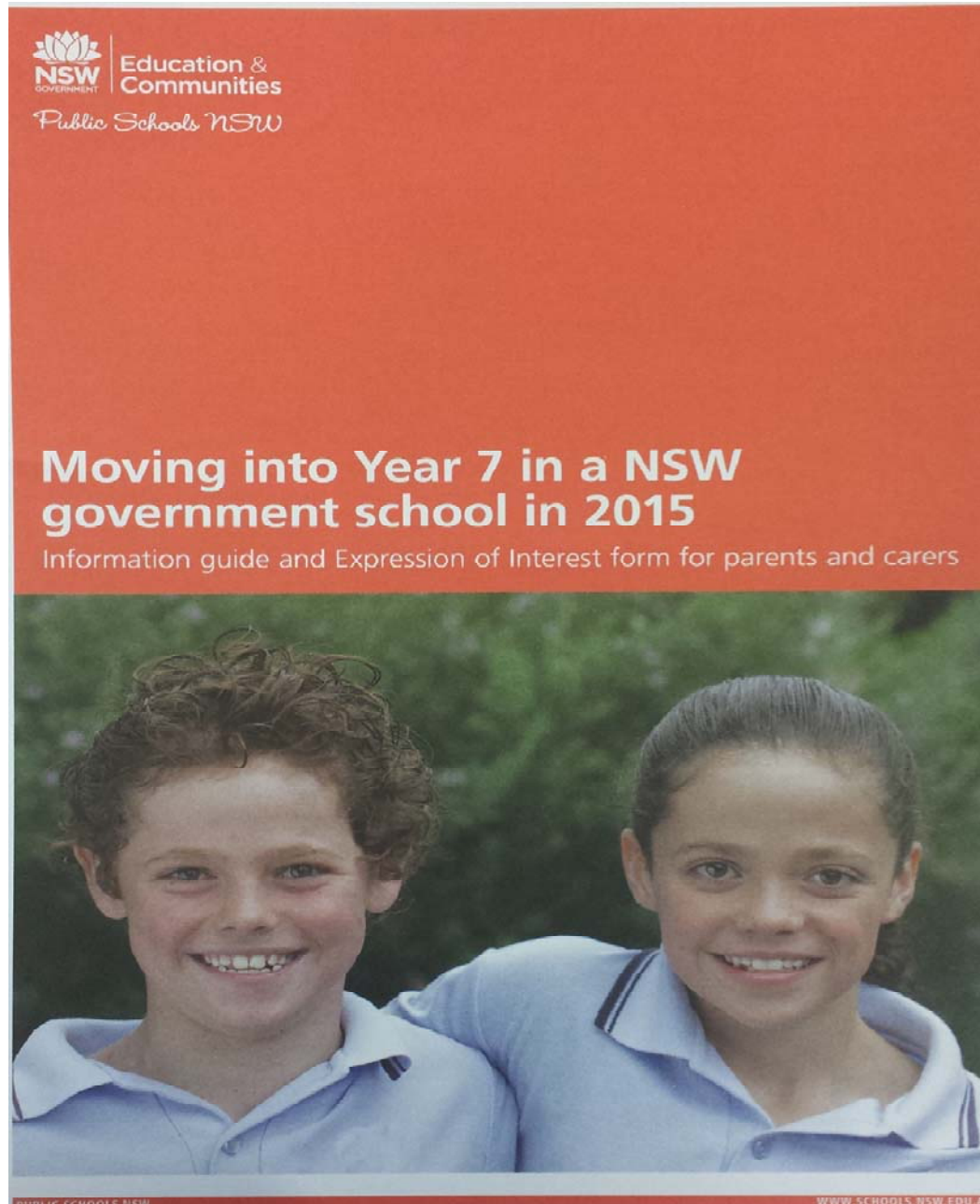


**Competing the Expression of Interest
Placement in Year 7, 2015 in a NSW government school for Epping Boys High School**



Section C

Epping Boys High School has only 180 positions available in Year 7. Some boys will not be able to attend the school. It is therefore important to fill in your choice 2 school.

The rest of the form does not need to be completed unless you are applying for:

- A third choice school
- An out of area school (Choice 2 or 3)
- An academically selective school (Section D)

Section C – Placement at other government schools

Other government school choices include:

- a **specialist** government school. Please note that specialist schools will have additional application requirements.
- a **specific program** in a government school. Please note that individual schools will have additional application requirements for specific programs.
- a **support class** through a placement panel to cater for students with additional learning and support needs.
- a **non-local** government school. Please outline your reasons for seeking non-local placement(s) at the bottom of this page (and on page 11 if required).
